

Guide for Swimming at the Pool Before Hotel Check-in

Step 1: Pack a Separate Pool Bag

Before arriving at the hotel, organize your pool essentials in a separate bag to avoid rummaging through your luggage. When you arrive, check your main luggage with valet and head straight to the pool with your pre-packed gear. Here's a checklist of items to include:

- **Phone**: For calls, music, and poolside selfies.
- **Credit Cards/Resort Band**: For easy purchases or access.
- **Pool Bag**: To carry all your poolside necessities.
- Extra Towel(s): In case the pool doesn't provide enough.
- **Swimwear**: Pack your swimsuit and a change of clothes.
- **Cover Ups**: Perfect for walking between the pool and other areas.
- **Pool Shoes**: Flip-flops or sandals for comfort.
- **Goggles**: If you plan to swim or play in the water.
- **Sunscreen**: Protect your skin from harmful UV rays.
- **Portable Charger & Cord**: Ensure your phone stays powered up.
- **Waterproof Phone Case**: Safeguard your phone while near water.
- **Plastic Bag for Wet/Dry Clothes**: Keep your dry clothes safe and stash wet ones after swimming.
- **Hairbrush/Comb**: Freshen up after the pool.
- **Deodorant**: Stay fresh for check-in.

Step 2: Decide What to Take to the Pool or Check with Valet

You can either bring your personal items like a **purse** or **laptop bag** to the pool or check them in with your luggage at valet for safekeeping.

Anytime - Shop the Sales
